

## SCHOOL PERFORMANCE DATA 2012

1. Djarindjin Lombadina Catholic School is situated 180km north of Broome on the Dampier Peninsula. The K-Year 10 school caters for the two Aboriginal Communities of Djarindjin and Lombadina as well as several outstations in the surrounding district. The school has five classes: K/PP/1, Years 2/3, Years 4/5, years 6/7 and a secondary class. 92% of students are Indigenous. Djarindjin Lombadina Catholic School educates children to follow Christian values and attitudes, to support the families as they hand on the faith, and to foster the personal growth of the children so they can be proud of their total heritage. The school strives to be a special place where the children can be free to be themselves, learn and develop at their own pace, and be challenged to reach their potential. The school promotes the active participation between itself and the community and supports the students' knowledge and respect for Aboriginal culture. Students are supported to develop their skills and knowledge which will prepare them for Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal society.

### 2. TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

Eight teachers are four year trained.

### 3. WORKFORCE COMPOSITION

Djarindjin Lombadina has 8 teachers (3 male & 5 female). There are 8 indigenous teacher assistants and 1 administration officer.
